1. A slight marginal increase in school fee and transport fee.
2. Parents who intend to take school leaving certificate for their wards are requested to apply for the same before 25th March 2025. **Applications received for School Leaving Certificate after 25th March 2025 will be liable to pay full fees for the subsequent months.**
3. For withdrawal of transport facility, one month's notice is necessary. This will however, be acceptable up to 31st of August 2025 only. No request for withdrawal of the facility will be accepted thereafter.
4. **Summer vacation** dates for classes **Nursery – 8th -- 26th May 2025, Monday till 02nd July 2025, Wednesday. School will re-open on 3rd July 2025, Thursday.**
5. **Summer vacation** dates for **Classes 9th & 10th -- 30th May 2025, Friday till 02nd July 2025, Wednesday. School will reopen on 3rd July 2025, Thursday.**
6. Please note the fee schedule for 2025-26 academic session will be strictly followed. Late fine will be charged after 15th of the month as mentioned in the school diary. Fee schedule is mentioned in the school diary. Please read the same.
7. We once again state that **half day is not allowed**. So, if the child is not well and you have to go somewhere with your child kindly apply for leave. Half day will not be sanctioned and is not allowed as per rules. Leave application should be sent before 08:00 am for us to mark the attendance accordingly. Half day policy is mentioned in the school diary. Please read the same and follow the same.
8. Health is of prime importance so if a child is not feeling well kindly keep the child at home for better care. Consult a doctor and do not send the child to the school till he/she fully recovers.
