Rules & Regulations for a Smooth Journey

- School Timings: Nursery 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM
L.KG. & U.K.G. 7:50 AM – 2:00 PM
- Punctuality is important: Late arrivals disturb learning.
- All Saturdays are off for Nursery, L.KG. & U.K.G.
- Attendance is mandatory: Inform by 8:00 AM in case of absence.
- Dress code: Neat and proper uniform every Wednesday house dress should be worn.
- School I-Card is mandatory: To wear all students.
- P.T.M. is mandatory: Inform earlier in case of absence.
- Label all belongings to avoid mix-ups.



Attendance & Leave Policy

- Parents must drop in a mail; in case the child is absent. Please plan leaves as per the school calendar, leaves during working days will not be approved.
- Any planned leave must be applied for in advance and notified at least 24 hours before.
- A medical leave certificate is required, in case the student is absent for more than 4 days due to medical reasons. A fitness certificate needs to be provided for a contagious ailment.
- Please schedule appointments (doctor / any other) after school hours as we will not allow students to leave early or come late.
- In case the student has any cold or flu-like symptoms kindly refrain from sending them to school.
- Any leave from 3 to 7 days needs approval from the principal in advance.
- Early dispersal or half-day will be approved only in case of an emergency, such as passport or visa appointments. Any such request needs to be mailed or informed well in advance.



Birthday Celebrations

- The students can come to school in smart casuals.
- Simple Sweets will be allowed to distribute by the student.
- Please do not send cake, chocolates and gifts.
- A storybook may be donated by the child for the class library.
- Please encourage your child to visit an orphanage, or old age home for their birthday.



Stay Connected

We believe in strong parent-school communication to ensure a smooth learning journey for your child. Stay connected through the School Diary & E-Care App for daily updates, homework, and important information. Urgent notifications are shared via WhatsApp broadcast, and regular Parent-Teacher Meetings help track progress. For any concerns, Saturday meetings can be scheduled by prior appointment

- Participate in School Activities – Attend PTMs, events, and workshops to stay involved in your child's progress.

Guidelines for Parents

Do's ✓

- Pack a healthy snack(fruits)/lunch.
- Check the school e-care app daily for updates.
- Check the school diary and acknowledge it daily.
- Send one or two toffee only on their birthdays.

Don'ts ✗

- Don't send expensive toys or valuables.
- Don't send fancy stationary.
- Don't send sharpener to avoid accidents.
- Avoid sending junk food.



Things to Bring on the First Day

- Label all the belongings before you submit it.
- An Extra set of clothes.
- A water bottle.
- A small lunch box with a fruit or a healthy snack.
- A handkerchief.
- A table mat(lunch break) and an apron.
- A diary for communication.
- Submit the stationery & fill 3 and 5 page of the diary.



Items to be submitted on the First Day

- Full set of primer books and Hindi book with labels.
- 2 Hindi (5 lines), 2 English (4 lines), 2 math, notebooks covered and labelled.
- The Hindi notebook cover should be green, the English notebook cover should be red, and the math notebook cover should be blue.
- One yoga mat or small rug for Yoga practice.
- One packet of colourful glitter sheets.
- One packet of colourful A4 sheets.
- One colourful tape.
- One any colour ribbon of $\frac{1}{2}$ cm width.
- One packet of oil pastel colour 12 shades of Doms.
- Three packets of Doms pencil.
- Six erasers.
- Three packet of multicolour stones for decoration.
- One 100gm fevicol.
- One waste plastic tray for play with play-dough and rice.
- One packet of six colourful play-dough with stencil and 250gm of waste rice.
